# NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

To be held by the Toronto East York Community Council (Under the Planning Act)

Request to Amend the Official Plan and the Zoning By-law Combined Application TE CMB 2002 006 (File No. 202008) Yorkville (2001) Limited

### PROPOSAL

The applications propose to amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-law for the properties at 76, 88R, 92 & 100 Yorkville Avenue and 95, 115, 119 & 121R Scollard Street to permit, in two phases, development of 18 and 8 storey, mixed use buildings with retail uses located on the ground and second storeys on Yorkville Avenue and 6 townhouses on Scollard Street. A total of 197 dwelling units are proposed. The proposal also includes the construction of a commercial underground parking garage to be operated by the Toronto Parking Authority. The existing Mt. Sinai Hospital heritage façade at 100 Yorkville Avenue will be preserved. Site-Specific Zoning By-law 382-93 that applies to the properties will be repealed.

Proposed amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning By-law include: an increase in permitted density from the maximum Official Plan density of 3.0 and 3.2 times the lot area and from the maximum Zoning By-law density of 2.0 and 3.0 times the lot area, to 4.0 times; an increase in the permitted height from 12.0 and 18.0 metres to 13.5, 28.4 and 55.6 metres; an increase in the area of the mechanical penthouse from 30% to 40% of the area of the roof of the building for the Phase One development; and an increase in the height of the mechanical penthouse from 5.0 metres to 5.5 metres for the Phase Two development.

As part of this development, the applicant will provide public benefits, in exchange for the proposed increase in height and density, to be secured through an agreement with the City under Section 37 of the Planning Act.


